## LARGER THAN LIFE: FORM AND VALUE

GOAL: students will draw from an actual object, focusing on form and value. students will choose a small object or use a provided smashed can. they will draw the object larger than life. the drawing will be finished with a wide range of values in the shading to represent texture and emphasize the form (three-dimensional).

## process steps:

- bring in an object or use an aluminum can supplied by teacher
- lay out your composition on your paper. your object needs to be significantly larger than lifesize and use most of your paper.
- draw your object lightly in pencil.
- use a variety of pencils (hard and soft leads) and blending tools to get different values. try to represent the texture, shadows, and highlights using value.
